Job Summary:

The BizOps Director is a crucial role within our nonprofit organization dedicated to building a zoological society organization. This position provides leadership and strategic guidance in the areas of business management, operations, and finance. The Director will work closely with the executive team and other volunteers to ensure the successful development and growth of the organization.

Responsibilities:

- Develop business plans and financial projections to support fundraising efforts and attract potential sponsors and donors.

Financial Management:

- Work with the Chief Financial Officer to oversee the financial operations of the organization and building of the zoo, including budgeting, financial reporting, and cash flow management.
- Monitor expenses and revenues to ensure financial sustainability and compliance with relevant laws and regulations.

Operations Management:

- Coordinate and oversee day-to-day operations of the organization, ensuring smooth functioning of the BizOp Department.
- Develop and implement operational policies and procedures to optimize efficiency and effectiveness.

Compliance and Regulatory Affairs:

- Ensure compliance with local, state, and federal regulations pertaining to zoo operations, safety, and animal welfare.
